## Important Information for IAS Annual Meeting Attendees

We are using the following buildings on campus: The Towers Center, McCollum Science Hall, Maucker Union, and Seerley Hall. Walking times between the Towers Center and the other buildings in the center of campus is about 10 - 15 minutes.

The IAS Registration Desk is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Towers Center. The Towers are located on the northwest side of campus across Hudson Road northeast of the UNI Dome. The Towers include the East Towers and West Towers with the Towers Center in between.

- • The first floor of the Towers Center is where the Rialto Dining Center is located.
- • The Registration Desk is located on the second floor at the west end of the Towers Center. Please enter the Towers Center through the ground floor door on the east side of the Center, walk up the stairs then to the west end of the Towers Center.

### Parking Regulations

- • Parking pass codes for the UNI MultiModal Transportation Center have been sent to all attendees who ordered one when registering. Directions how to access the ramp were included in the email. The code is good for Friday only. Saturday parking is open in most UNI parking lots. Do not park in C or CP lots.
- • Parking on residential streets will be much easier on Saturday.
- • There will be a limited number of campus maps at the Registration Desk.
